How many should be in my group?

- As few or as many as you'd like! This is totally up to you, depending on when you'll be meeting and what works best for you.

Who will "lead" my group?

- You all will! Each study has a simple discussion guide at the end of each week with questions that come from that week's lessons. People in your group can take turns asking the questions. Aside from completing the study, there is no additional preparation needed!

I don't know who I could meet with for the semester. Is there a way for me to get connected?

- Yes! Please don't let this stop you from signing up! On the Realm registration form, you'll note that you would like to get connected with a group and answer a few simple questions. Elyse will then contact you to connect you with a group.

Could my group meet at church?

- For this semester, groups can use church meeting rooms to meet. Space is available first-come, first-served. Rooms are cleaned frequently and set for social distancing. Guidelines for mask-wearing, cleaning, and general use of the rooms are outlined [here](#) (LINK THE DOCUMENT ATTACHED TO EMAIL) and would be expected to be met for those meeting on-campus. Please note that childcare would not be available, even if meeting on-campus.

Our group would be most comfortable meeting online. Is there a way for us to do that?

- Absolutely! MOMS has a paid Zoom account that is available for any group meeting online. Only one meeting can happen at a time, so time slots are first-come, first-served. Email Elyse (elyse.peggar@vcgurnee.org) to reserve your slot.

Can't I just do the studies on my own?

- Of course you can, but we believe this studies will be most fruitful done together, however that might look like for you (in-person or online). We trust that even talking with one other person over the study will encourage you and strengthen you in your motherhood!
